


## **Rochotte**

A forest excursion which shells, with the liking of perforated, from beautiful points of view on Champagney, its vast basin and the valley of Rahin. Many brooks push the ditty in underwood.

- Geology: Observe an alternation of dark and friable rocks and volcanic rocks compact.
- Forest: Oaks and beeches alternate harmoniously.
- Flora: Throughout the way, discover mélampyres, the digital ones, brooms, callunes and ancolies.
- History: Field formerly of "wood tumble" where the coppice of oaks was exploited in full sap, every 13 years in spring. The bark then was separated and dried to be delivered to the tanneries. The last tannery to have bought bark was that of the "Thilllot" towards end of the year 50.

One joined the starting point while transfering on the left after the war memorial of Champagney, direction the "Mount of greenhouse". After 400 m, an arrowing directs on the left to join the circuit.

A broad marked out way of yellow triangles brings you to the true departure where a signpost is with plan.



Follow on the right, a way bordered of brooks until from the point of view of the "Rochotte" which makes discover the valley, of Belfort with Ronchamp, and in favorable weather in the morning the mounts of the Jura and the Alps Suisses.

Follow the watershed.

Transfer on the left by the way marked out in yellow triangles. Important slope.

Take on the left, direction the "Champey" by the way in balcony which, with hillside joined the brook of "Attemas" and the starting point.
